## ELIGIBILITY AND JUDGING CRITERIA

- *The Fleet Safety Awards are open to any carrier operating three (3) or more vehicles or combination of vehicles.*
- *The company must be a member in good standing with MTA.*
- *Use mileage and accidents from **Michigan only** to calculate frequency.*
- *Use data from January 2021-December 2021.*
- *Mileage classes will be established in each division.*
- *A separate report must be filed for each major division representing a type of service performed within the state.*
- *Nominees providing local pickup, delivery service and over-the-road service may report separate breakdowns of miles and accidents for each type of operation.*
- *Frequency is calculated using the following formula:*

$$\frac{\text{NUMBER OF MICHIGAN ACCIDENTS X 1 MILLION (1,000,000)}}{\text{TOTAL MICHIGAN MILEAGE}}$$

- *Use both "traffic" and "non-traffic" accidents to compute the frequency rate.*
- *A reportable accident is defined by the American Trucking Associations rules as, "an occurrence involving property damage and/or death or injury, except those where the fleet vehicle is properly parked."*
- *All entries may be subject to an audit.*
- *Fleets with the lowest frequency rate in each division receive an award. The Grand Trophy is then awarded to one of the division winners based on additional safety information.*
